UMS USER ID AND PASSWORD

To access UMS, go to www.lpu.in and Click on UMS Login link on the top left corner (Location is always to be selected as Head Office)

FOR STUDENT



- User Id** Provisional Reg. No. of the student
(If Provisional Reg. No. is 12300010, user Id will be 12300010)
- Password** Already sent through SMS and E-mail as per details provided to university. If not received, the same can be retrieved as per the process mentioned below.

FOR PARENTS



- User Id** Type P followed by Provisional Reg. No. of the student
(If Provisional Reg. No. is 12300010, user Id will be P12300010)
- Password** Already sent through SMS and E-mail as per details provided to university. If not received, the same can be retrieved as per the process mentioned below.

To retrieve a forgotten UMS password, students or parents can follow these steps:

1. Go to the LPU Admit portal under post admission services or access the link - <https://ums.lpu.in/lpuums/forgetpassword.aspx>
2. Enter the registration number. For parents, the letter "P" needs to be added in the user ID section along with their ward's registration number (e.g., P12300010).
3. Enter the date of birth.
4. An email will be sent to the registered email address with a link to reset the password.
5. Click on the link and follow the instructions to create a new password.
6. Alternatively, you can call our helpline number 01824-517438 to reset your UMS account password.

Note: It is important to ensure that all the information provided is accurate to successfully reset the UMS password.
